Data processing method(s)	Personal Data will be processed with automated and non-automated tools, in compliance with specific and adequate security measures, pursuant to art. 5, par. 1, lett. f) of the GDPR. Personal Data are processed and stored at the University headquarters.

Data Retention Policy	<p>The storage period of your Personal Data is established for a timeframe not exceeding the period required to attain the scopes for which they were collected and processed, and in compliance with the deadlines set forth by law.</p> <p>Where video conferencing applications are used to record meetings, your Personal Data captured within the recording are stored within the cloud service owned by Teleconference Microsoft Teams. The recordings will be available to Learners (therefore, they will not be downloadable) for a limited number of weeks / months (approximately up to a maximum of two months).</p>
Recipient(s) of Personal Data	<p>Within the limits pertinent to the processing purposes indicated, the data will be communicated and/or in any case accessible to the teachers of the chosen course of study, to the employees and collaborators in charge of the competent offices of the University, in their capacity as authorized subjects for processing.</p> <p>Moreover, Personal Data will be communicated to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - IEEE Sensors Council Italy Chapter
Transfer of Personal Data to non-EU countries	<p>The collected data will not be transferred to Countries or international organizations outside the territory of the European Union.</p>
