INFORMATION NOTICE FOR CANDIDATES PARTICIPATING IN SELECTION PROCEDURES FOR INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY PROGRAMMES

(pursuant to EU Regulations 679/2016)

This notice is pursuant to article 13 of Regulations (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons and personal data (“GDPR”). It provides main information on the processing of personal data collected by the Università degli Studi di Roma “Foro Italico” (“University” and/or “Data Controller”) based on the purposes listed below.

By processing of personal data, we mean any operation or set of operations, carried out by the University with or without the aid of automated processes and applied to personal data, collected, recorded, modified, processed, adapted, consulted, communicated, transmitted, disseminated, made available, compared, interconnected, deleted, destroyed.

Any refusal to provide personal data will result in the controller's inability to acquire information relevant to the improvement of its services, the impossibility for the University to communicate contact details to students who request them in order to share similar experiences, and the</p>	

	<p>impossibility to adequately disseminate the results of mobility projects and increase their visibility.</p> <p>The provision of data for the purposes of point q) is optional, provided that in the absence of such data the University will not be able to guarantee either any additional score in ranking, or the access to additional funding specifically provided by international mobility programmes or support in the host institutions, where applicable.</p> <p>Processing of aggregated or anonymous data does not require application of the Privacy Code and the GDPR.</p>

Data storage time	<p>Collected data will be detained for the time strictly necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes, without prejudice to any retention terms imposed by the law or other regulations. Data will be stored in accordance with regulations on the retention of administrative documents.</p> <p>For instance, data concerning ranking, minutes or credits acquired abroad may be kept indefinitely also for historical interest and in accordance with the archiving obligations imposed by the current legislation (D.P.R. 28 December 2000 n. 445, D.Lgs. 22 January 2004 n. 42, D.P.C.M. 3 December 2013).</p>
Rights of data subjects	<p>Data subject at any time may exercise his/her rights by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - asking the Data Controller (by writing to the e-mail privacy@uniroma4.it, using the form available in the University website in the section Privacy) in accordance with articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 of the GDPR, access to his/her own personal data and obtain data update, rectification or erasure or limit their processing; object to processing of personal data as well as the right to data portability. Cancellation is not permitted for data contained in records that must be retained by the University. - lodging a complaint with the Supervisory Authority responsible for data protection (Garante Per La Protezione Dei Dati Personali, Piazza Venezia 11, Roma, protocollo@pec.gpdp.it, https://www.garanteprivacy.it).
