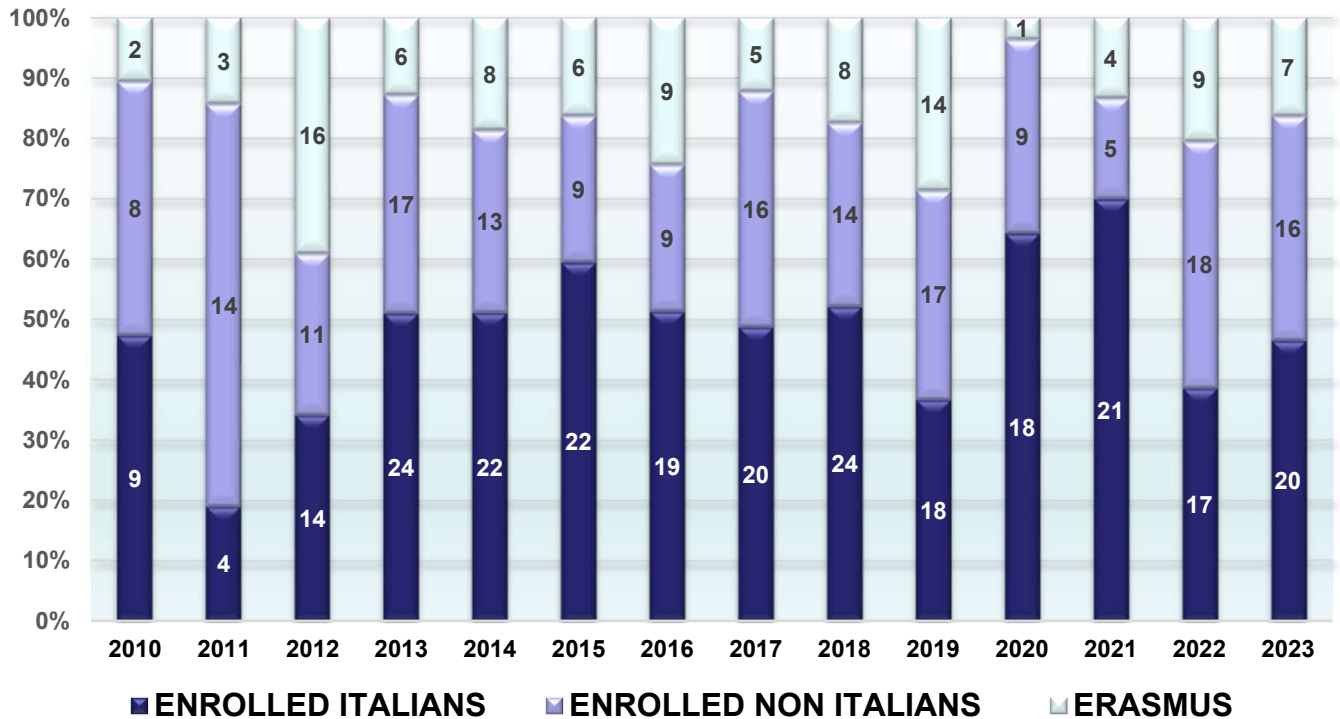

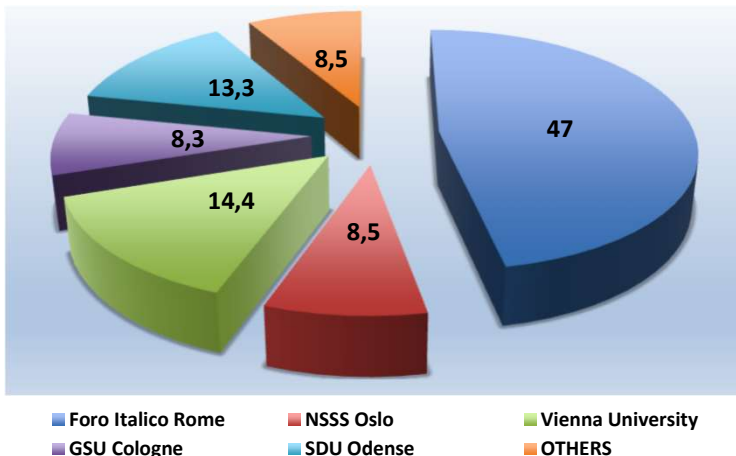

## Main figures and quality assurance indicators 2022-2023 plus 4-year trend

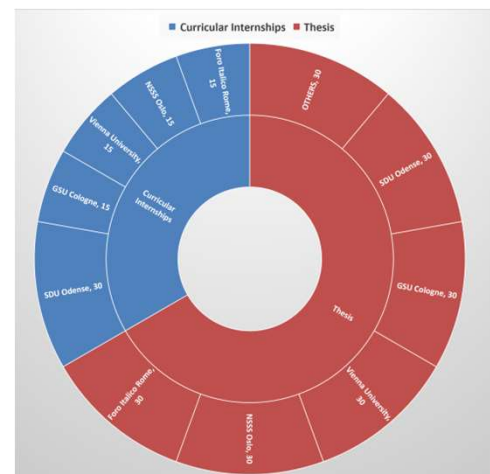
### Students enrolled/admitted to the EMH&PA program 2010-2023

Contribution of European partner universities to the 2nd year teaching activities (ECTS)



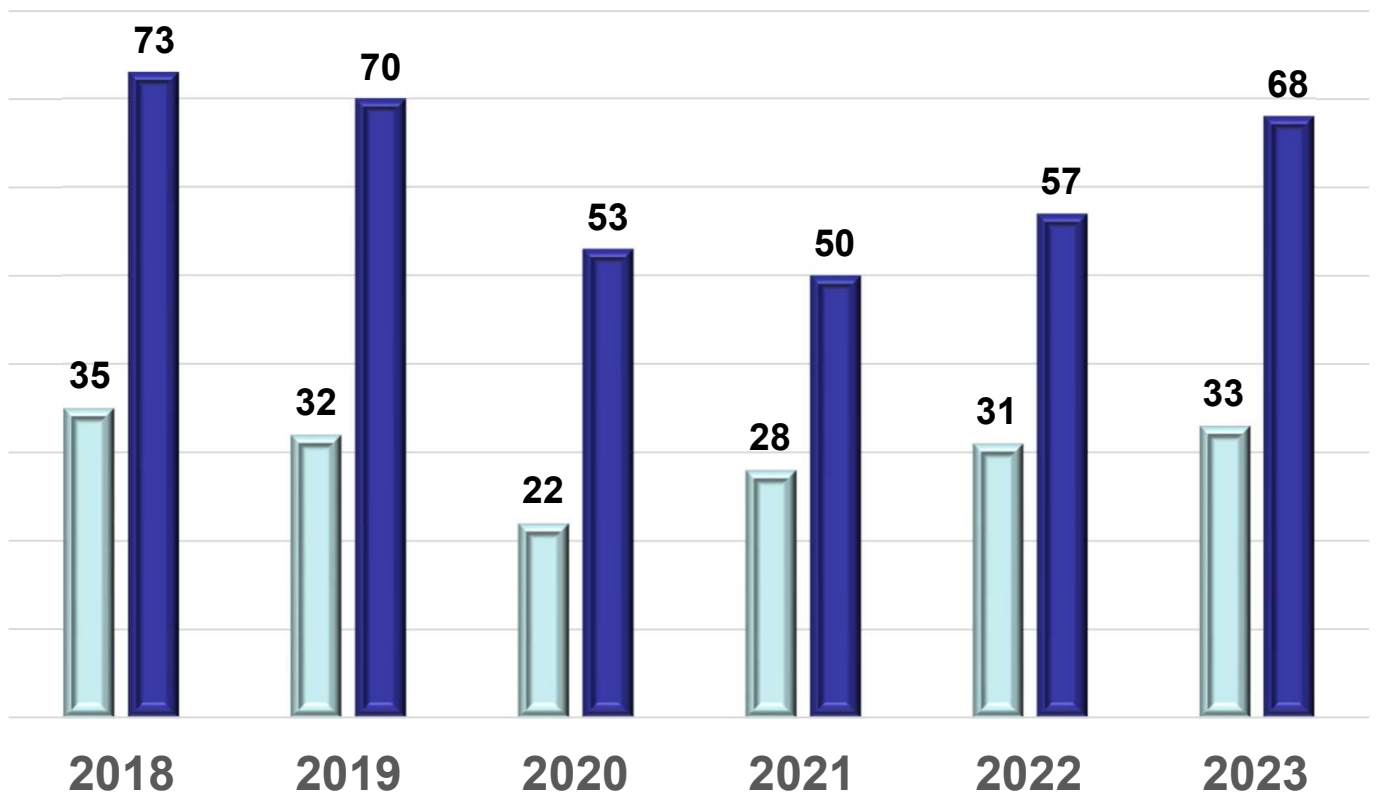

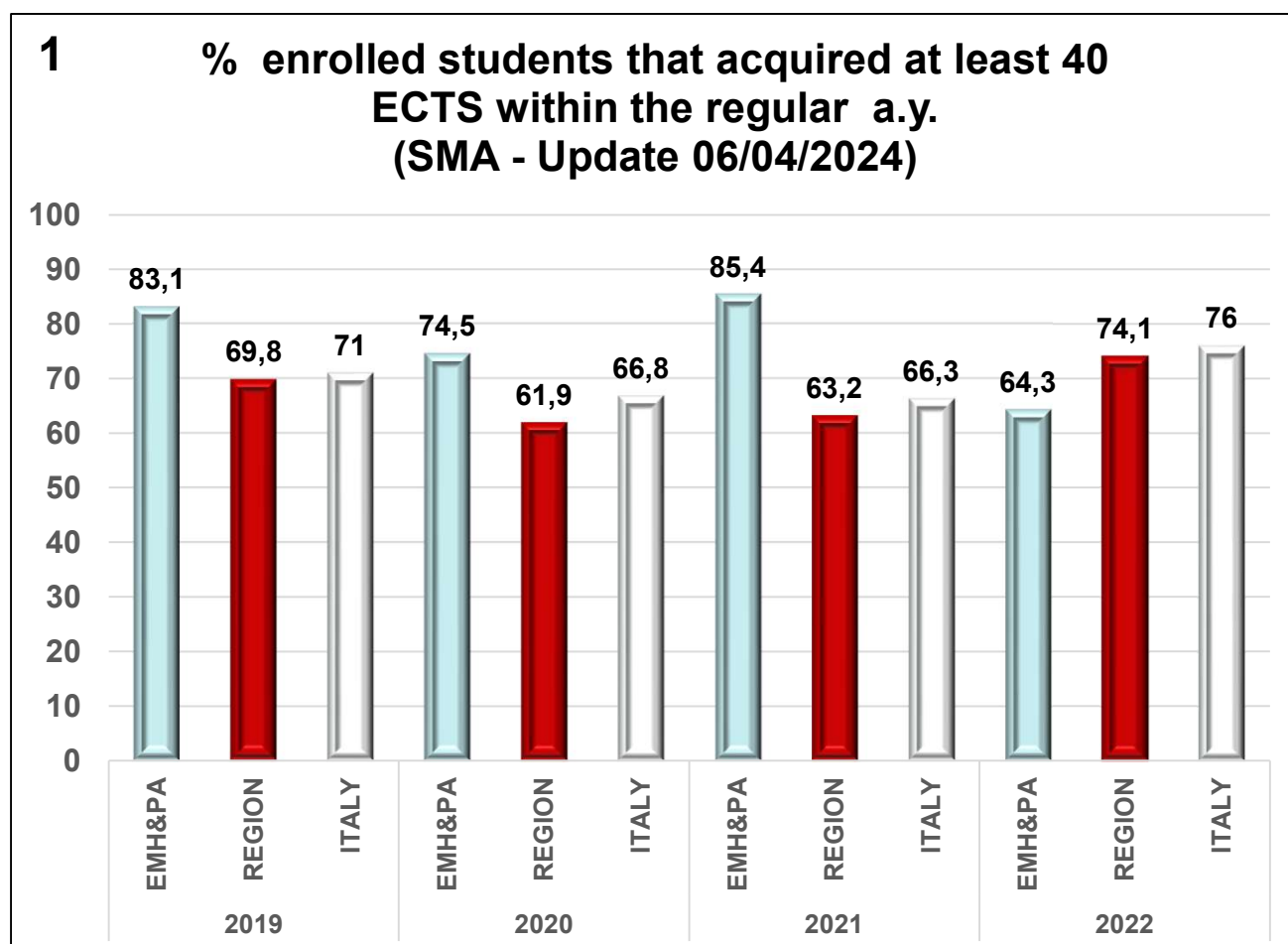

# REGULARITY OF STUDENT CAREERS

(Indicators from MIUR-SMA annual monitoring – update June 2024)

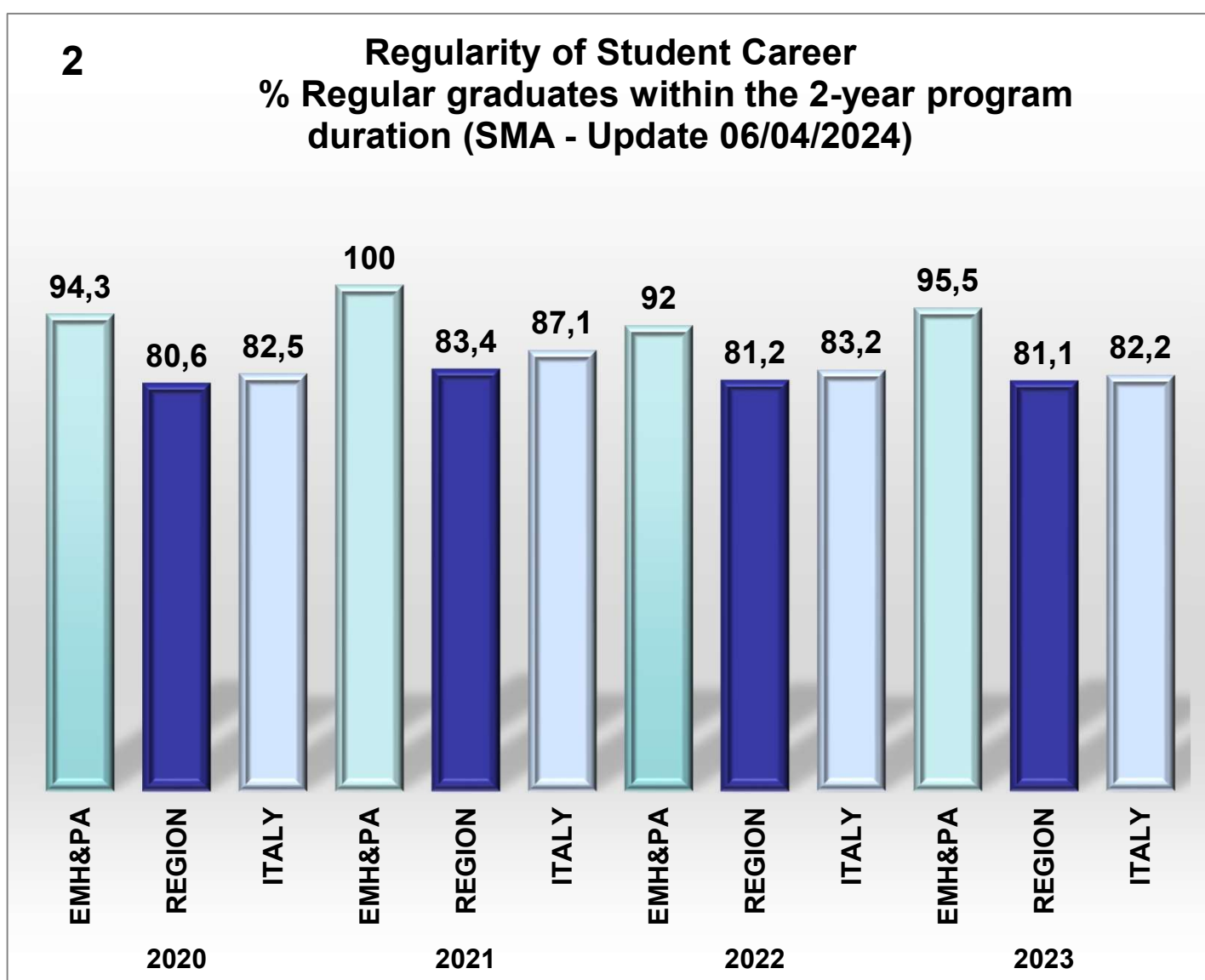
Regular students show a good percentage of ECTS acquired at the end of the 1st year (between 86-93%), always higher when compared to the situation at regional and national level for the same II level programs (1), with the exception of the data from 2022, possibly depending upon the temporal mismatch of credits for the Research Methodology course, which are acquired by students from the University of Vienna in the first semester of the second year.



## REGULARITY OF STUDENT CAREERS

(Indicators from MIUR-SMA annual monitoring – update June 2024)

*Not less than 96% of students progress towards the 2nd year of the study program, with an excellent percentage of graduates (between 92-100%) within the program duration (2).*

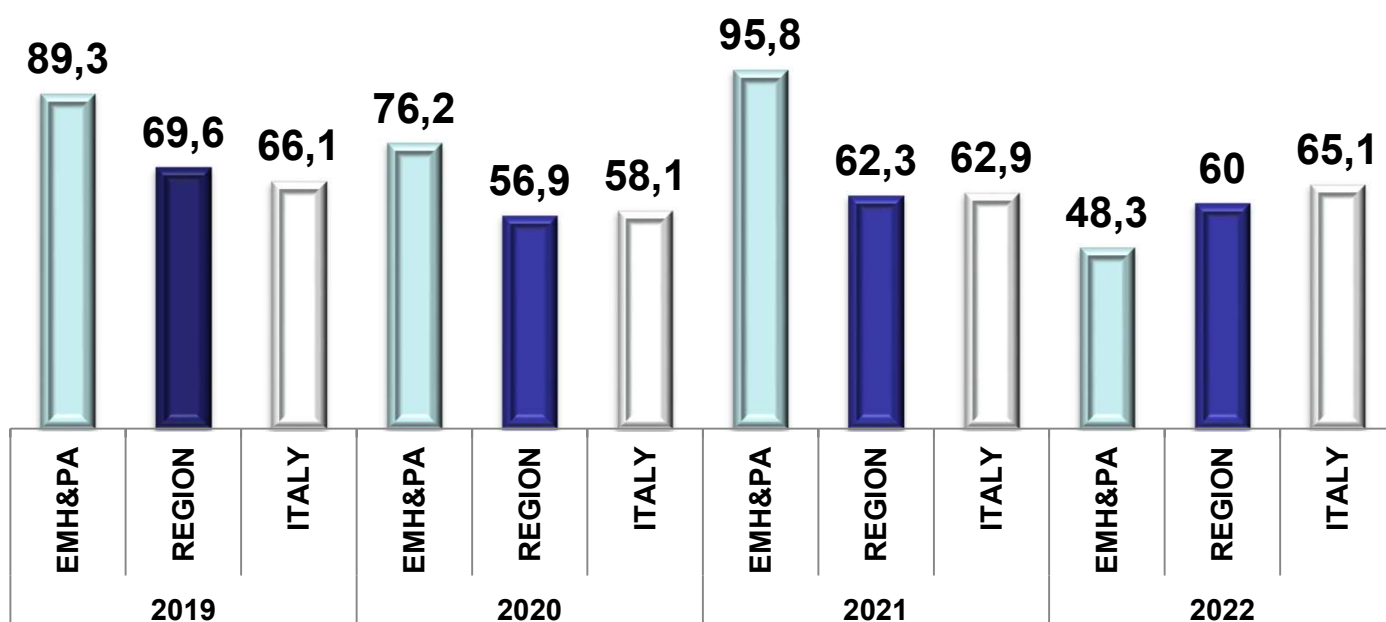


## REGULARITY OF STUDENT CAREERS

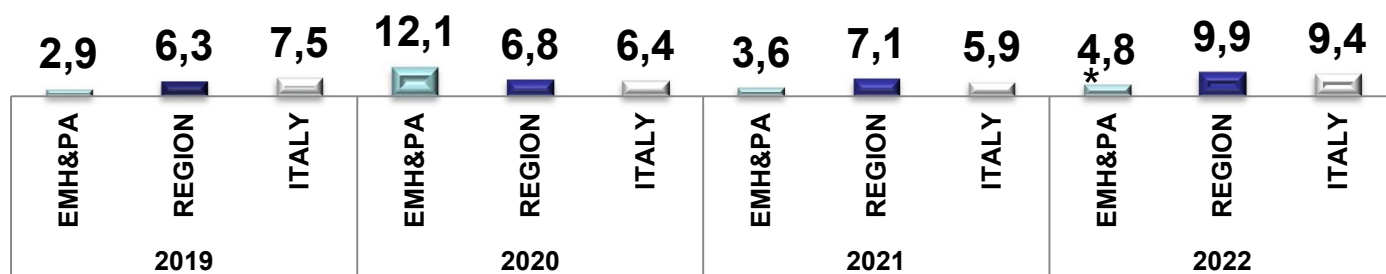

The percentage of regular students acquiring 2/3 of mandatory ECTS within the 1 year, usually stable around 80-90%, shows a dramatic decrease in 2022, not reflecting the actual data from the institutional database and likely referring to a not-consolidated value (3). The percentage of students that withdraw from the program shows a stable trend in 2021 and 2022, lower than the regional and national picture (4).

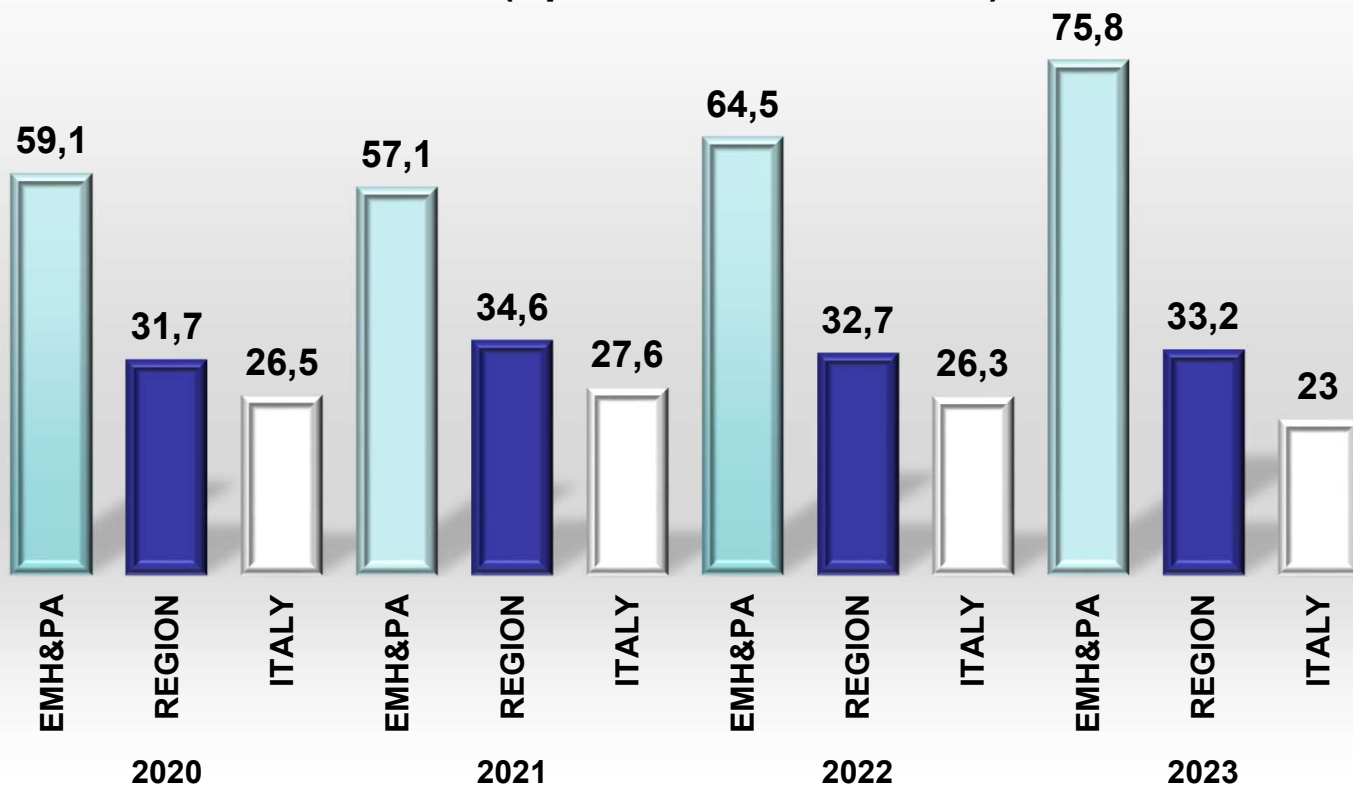


# ATTRACTIVENESS AND INTERNATIONALIZATION OF THE STUDY PROGRAM

(Indicators from MIUR-SMA annual monitoring – update June 2024)

The attractiveness of LM67-I study program at national and international level is verified by the high percentage of bachelor graduates from universities other than Foro Italico (5), with a positive trend in 2022 and 2023.

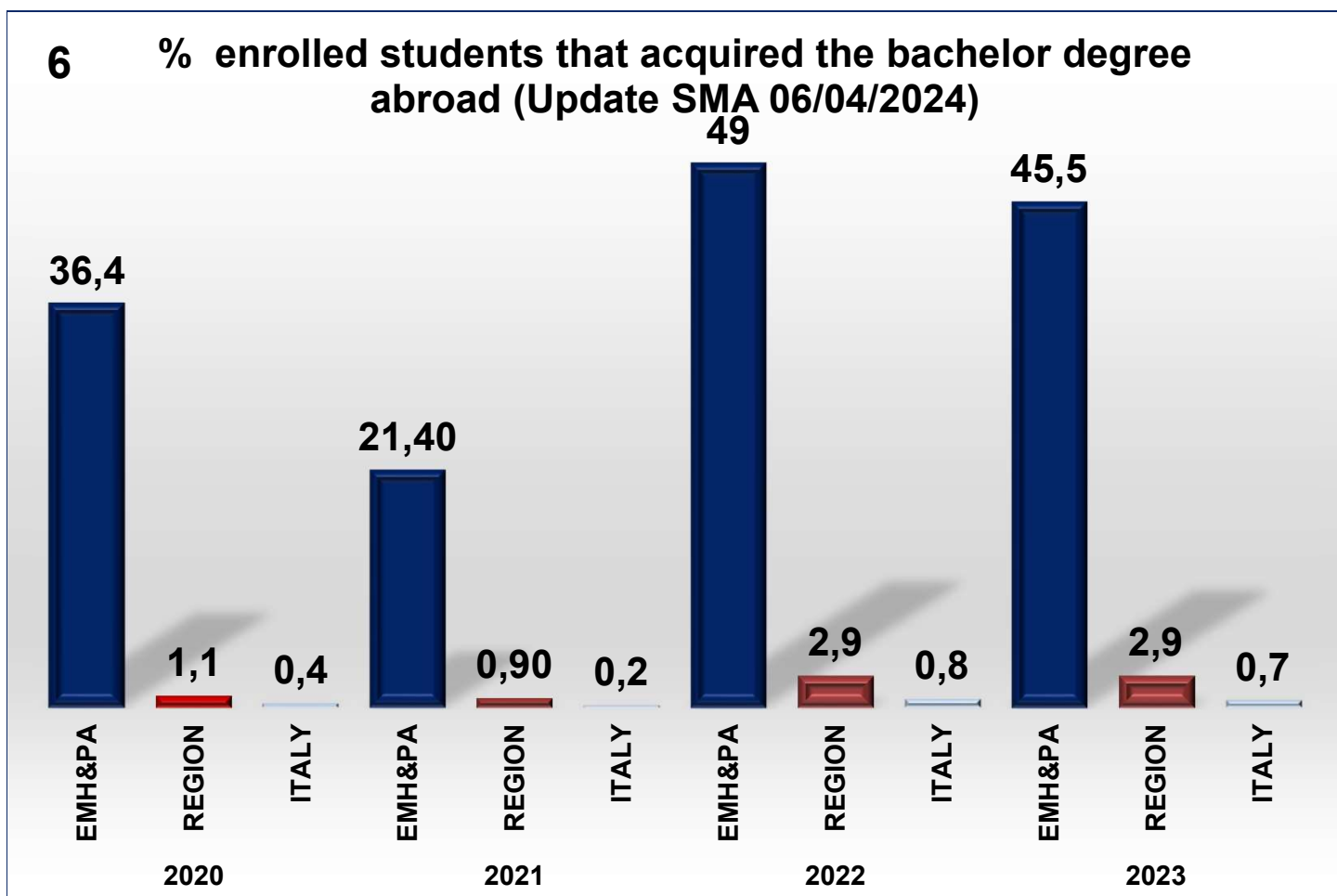
## 5 Attractiveness of the study program - Enrolled students from universities other than Foro Italico (Update SMA 06/04/2024)



# ATTRACTIVENESS AND INTERNATIONALIZATION OF THE STUDY PROGRAM

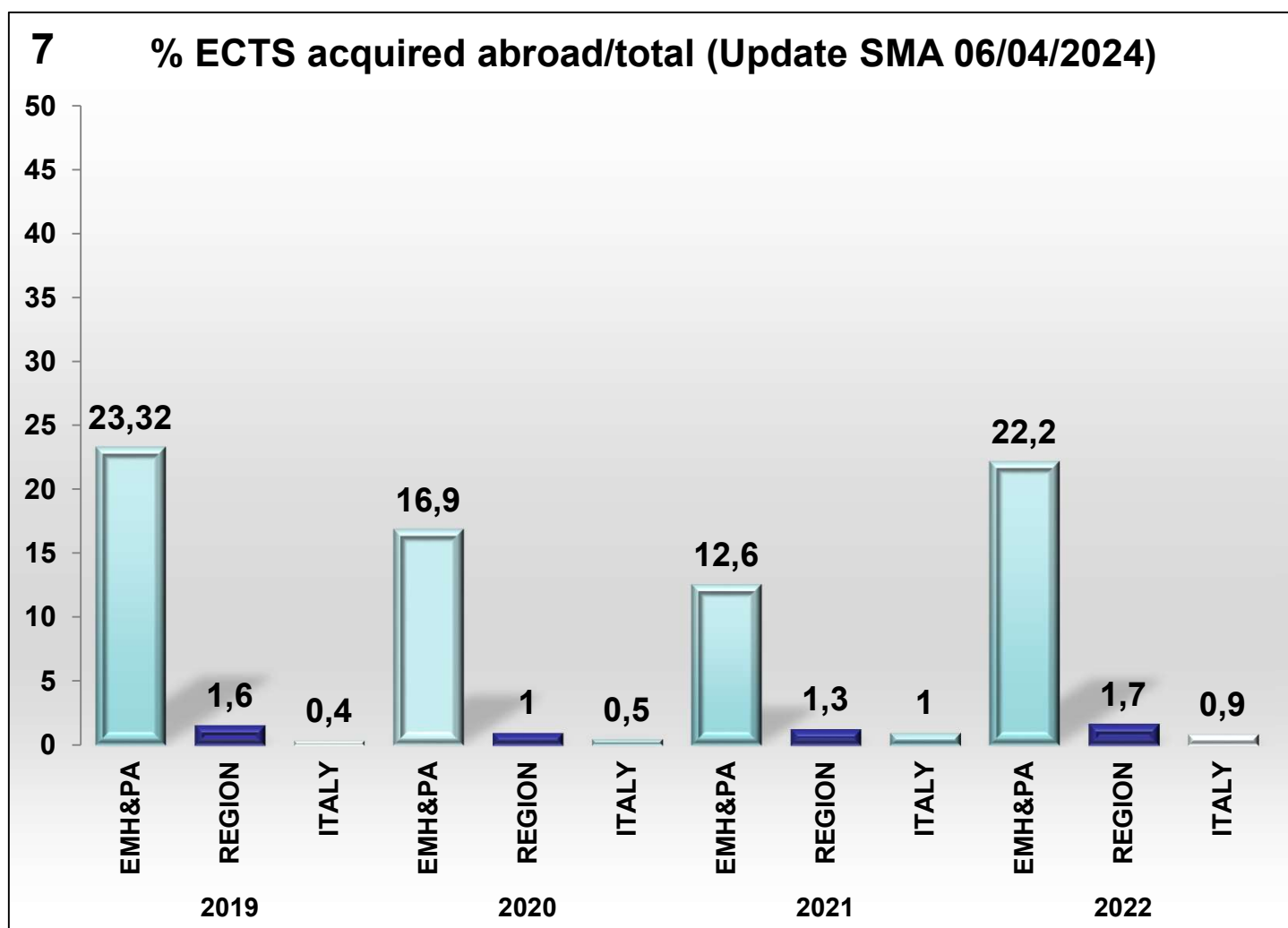
After the restriction to the international mobility possibly due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the attractiveness of LM67-I study program at international level shows a very good trend, stable in the 2022 and 2023 academic years, with 46-49% of enrolled students with a bachelor degree acquired abroad (6).



# ATTRACTIVENESS AND INTERNATIONALIZATION OF THE STUDY PROGRAM

(Indicators from MIUR-SMA annual monitoring – update June 2024)

The % of ECTS acquired abroad is very high, in line with the structure of the joint program, requiring a mandatory 12,5% amount. The higher percentage shown up to the a.y. 2018/19, reflecting the students' interest towards international training experiences, decreases in 2019/2020 and 2020/21, possibly related to the difficulties to attend elective activities abroad because of the COVID-19 restrictions, is back to previous value in 2021/22 (7).

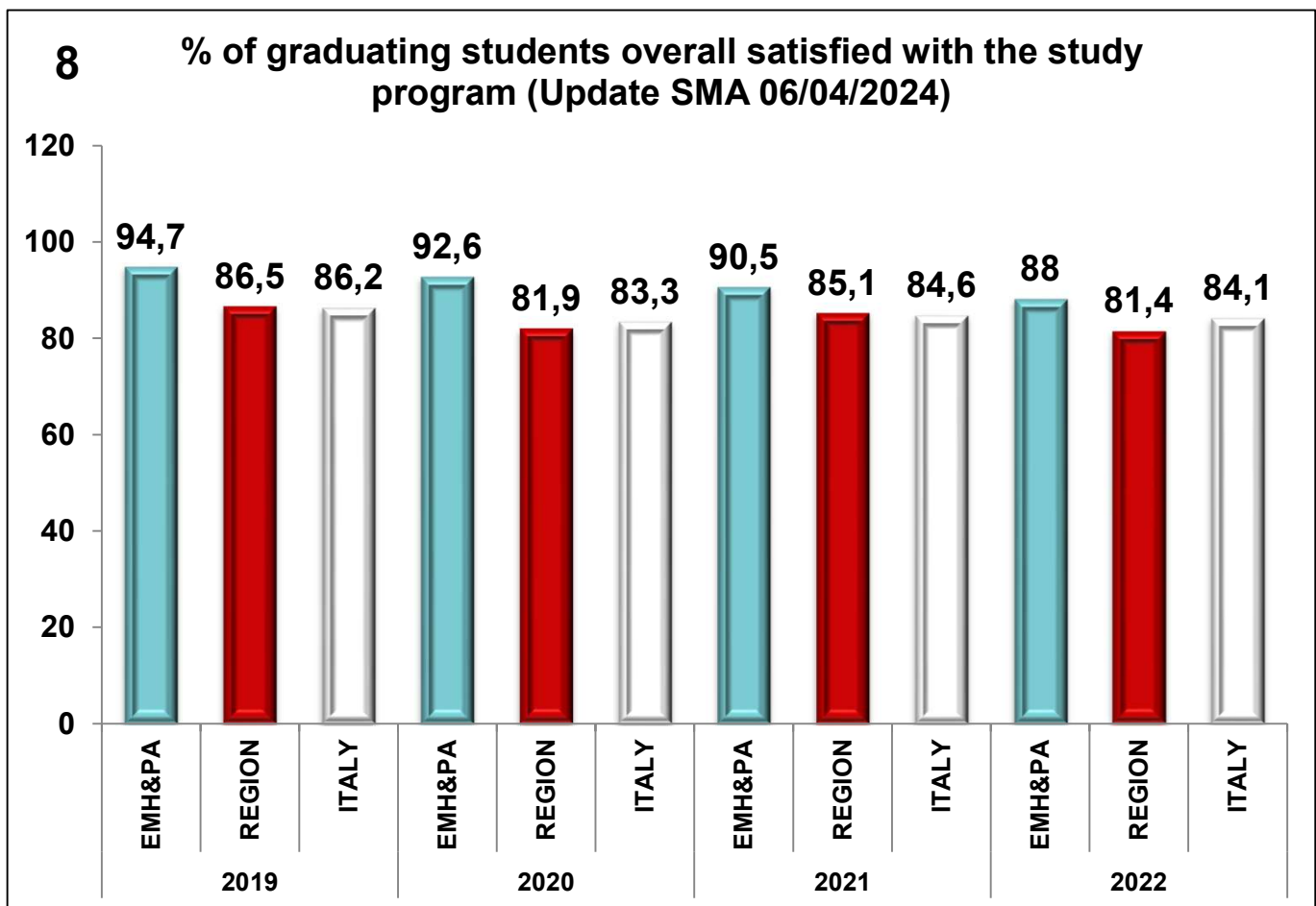




# PROGRAM SATISFACTION BY GRADUATING STUDENTS

The program satisfaction by graduating students (8) shows a stable 4-year trend, with a small decrease in 2022, higher or comparable to the Italian regional or national situation, and reflecting their trends.



# PROGRAM SATISFACTION BY GRADUATING STUDENTS

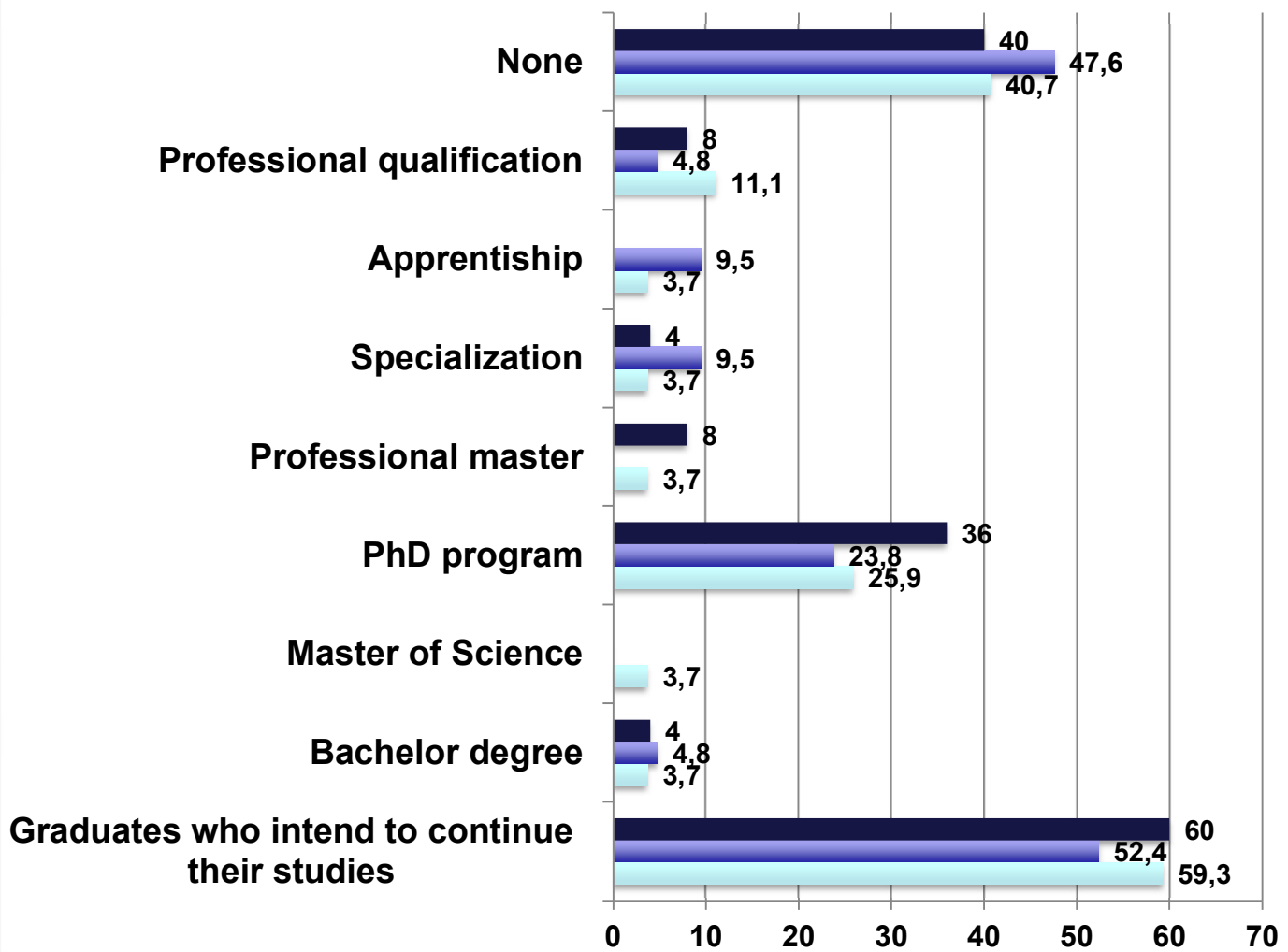

The Alma-Laurea survey shows that the interest of graduating students in entering a PhD program is increased to 36% in 2022, while about 16% intend to continue with a specialization or with a professional master.

Graduates who intend to continue their studies after the MSc degree (2020 - 2022 Alma Laurea survey, %)

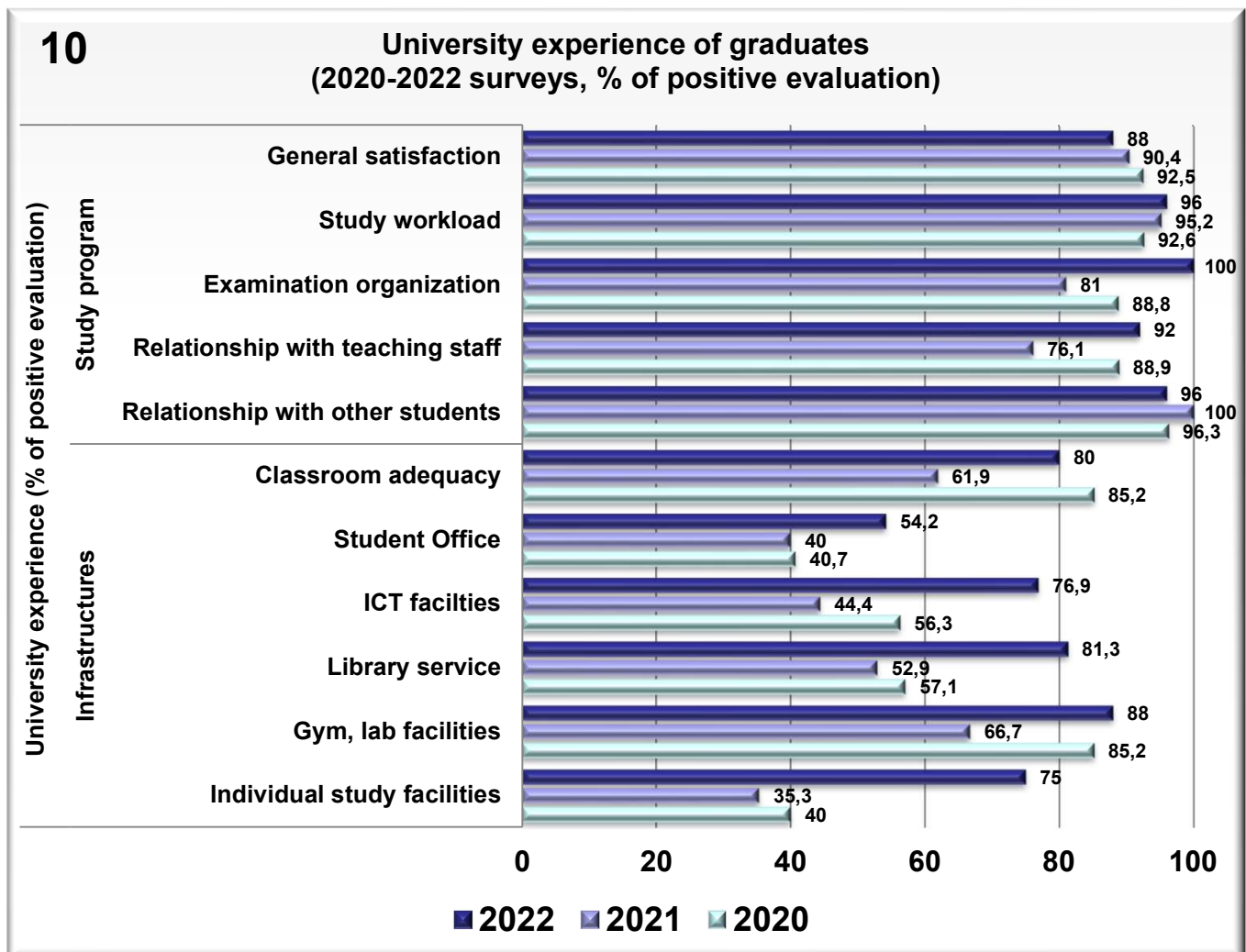
■ 2022 ■ 2021 ■ 2020



# PROGRAM SATISFACTION BY GRADUATING STUDENTS

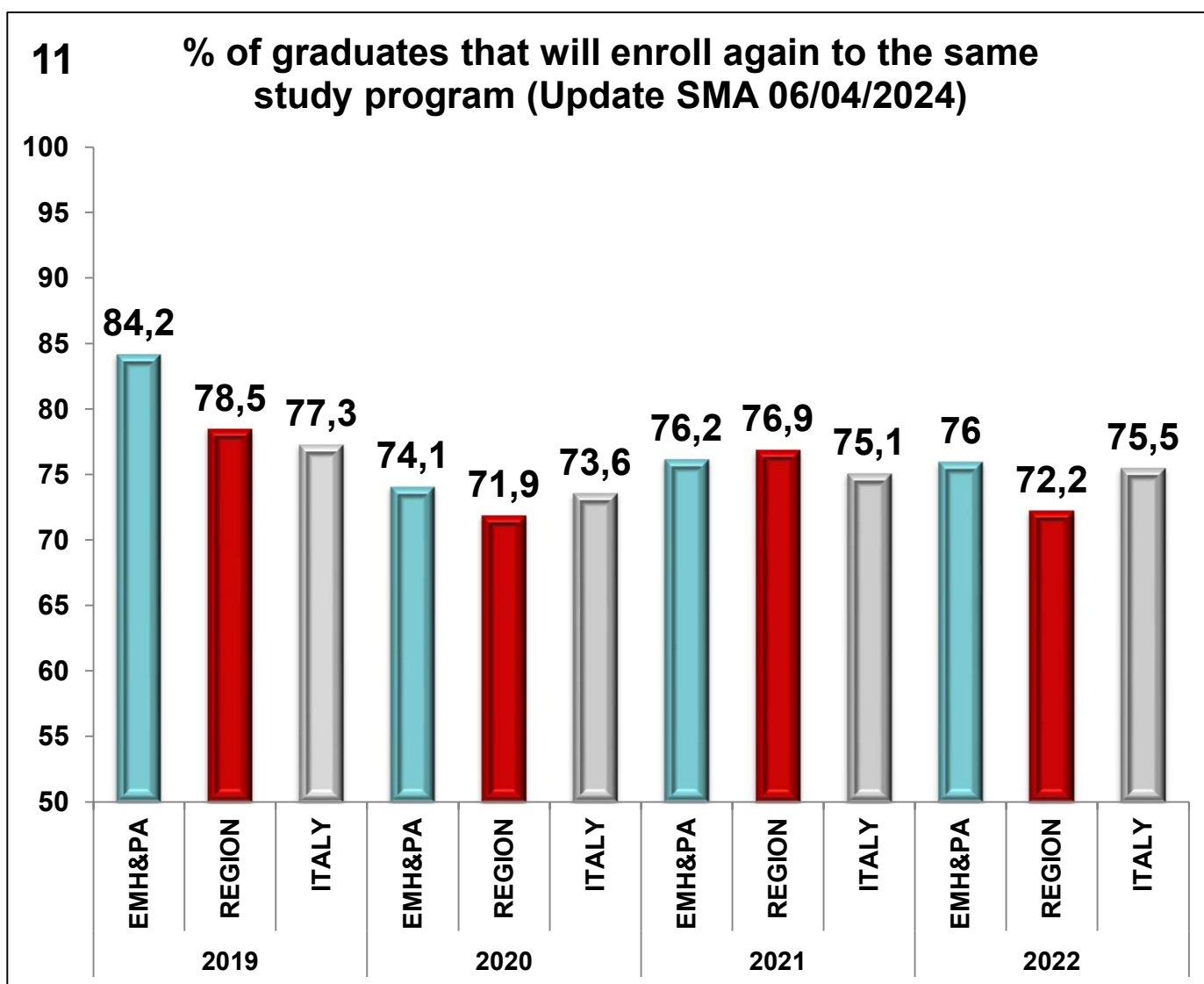
The general program satisfaction by graduating students shows a stable and positive 3-year trend, with an excellent satisfaction towards the relationship with the teachers (up to 92%) and with other students (up to 100%). Excellent satisfaction also toward the exams' organization (up to 100%) and study workload (up to 96%). On the rise is the positive evaluation toward administrative and study support facilities (10).

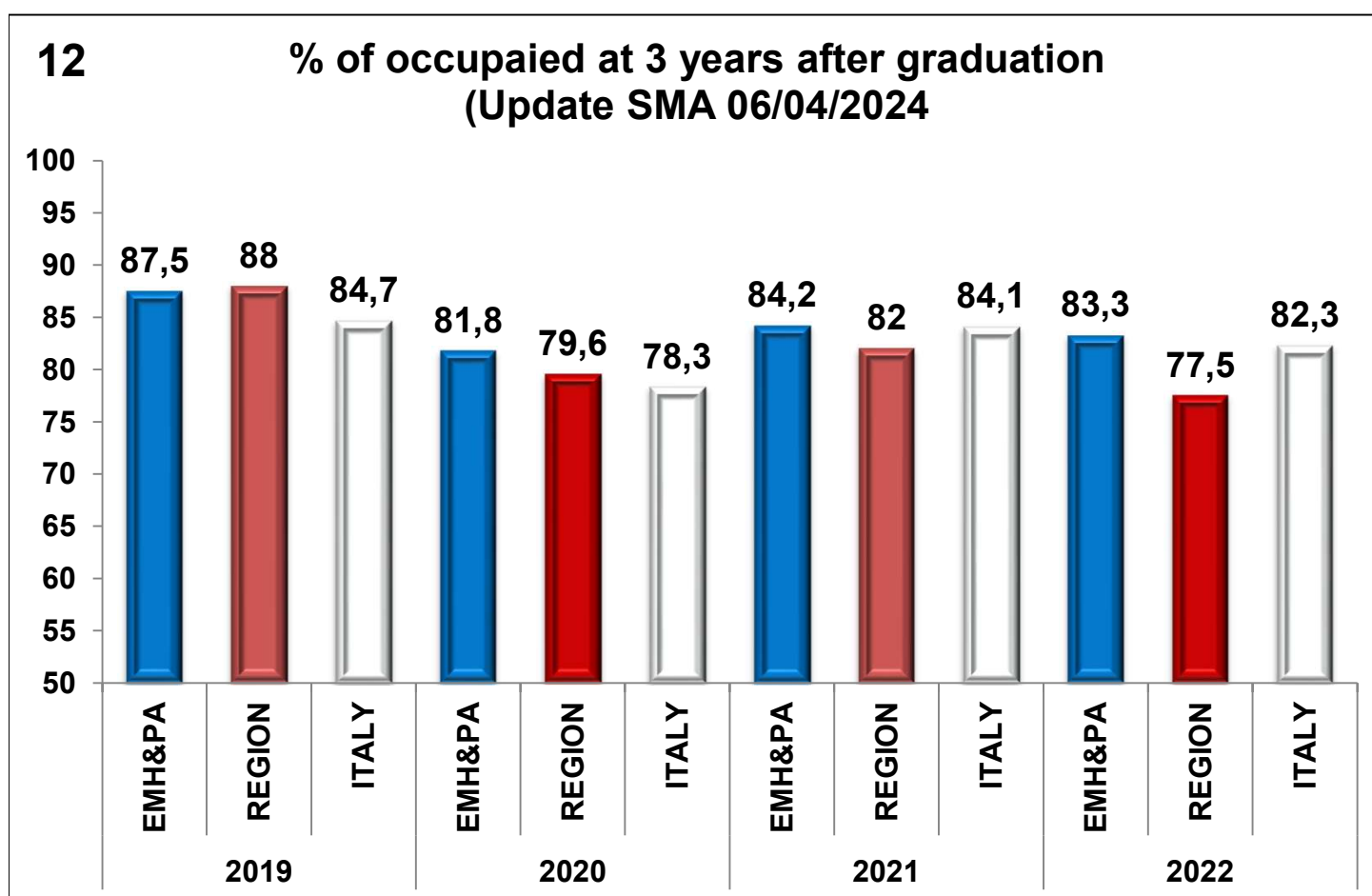
Similar picture is shown for the program satisfaction by graduates (11), with lower values in the last three years (74-76%) with respect the 2019 value (84,2%), but comparable to the Italian regional or national trends.



# EMPLOYABILITY OF EMHPA (LM67-I) GRADUATES

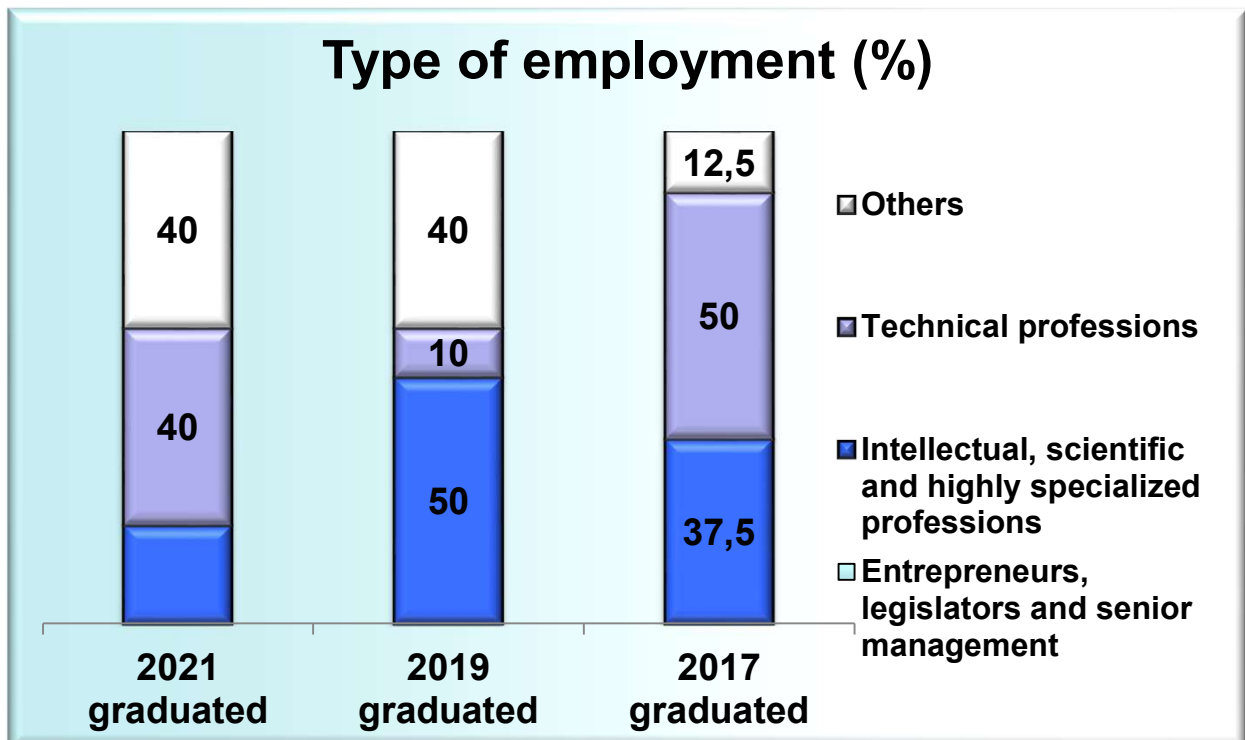
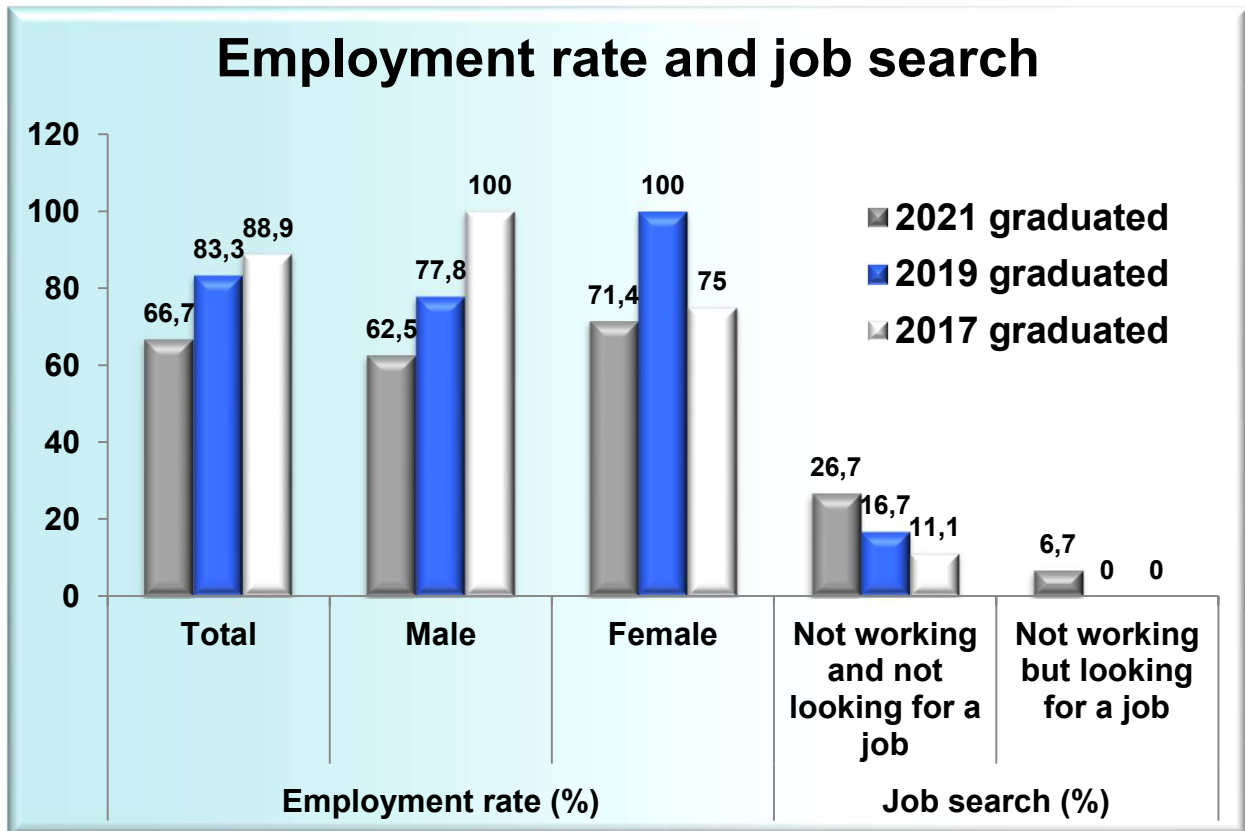

The employability (job/doctorate) of graduates after 3 years from the program completion is stable, between 82-88%, in line with the situation at regional or national level.



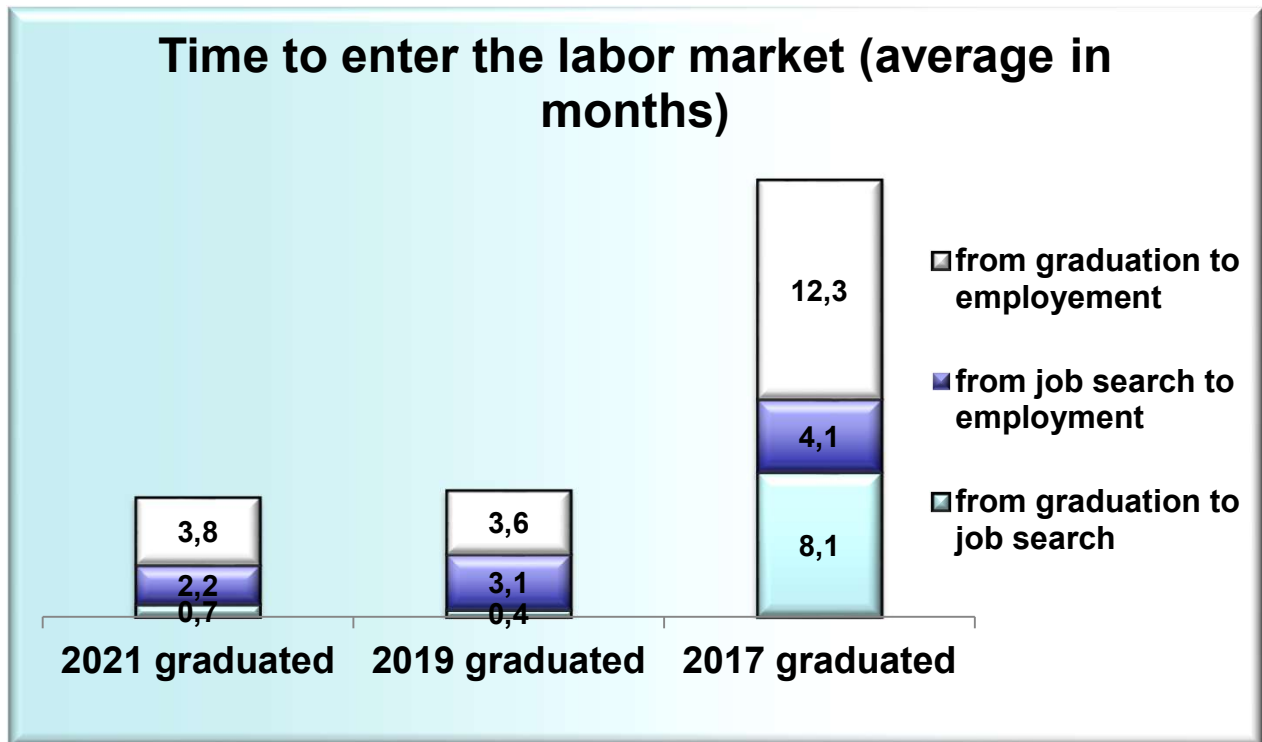
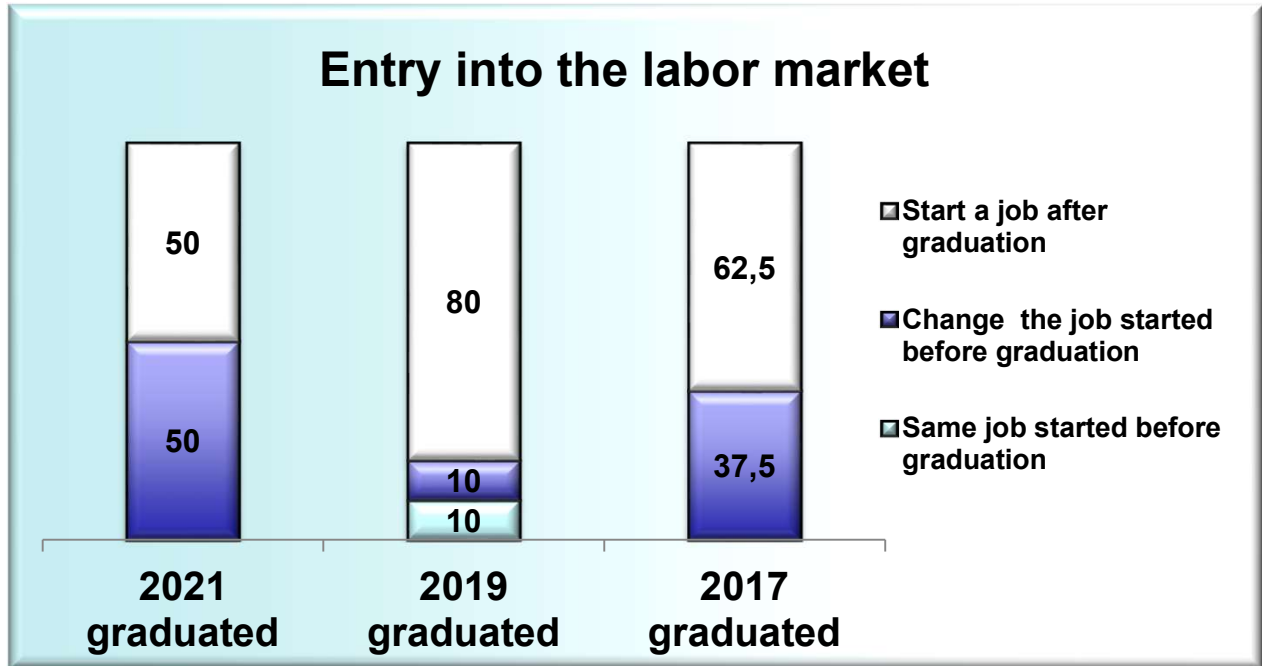

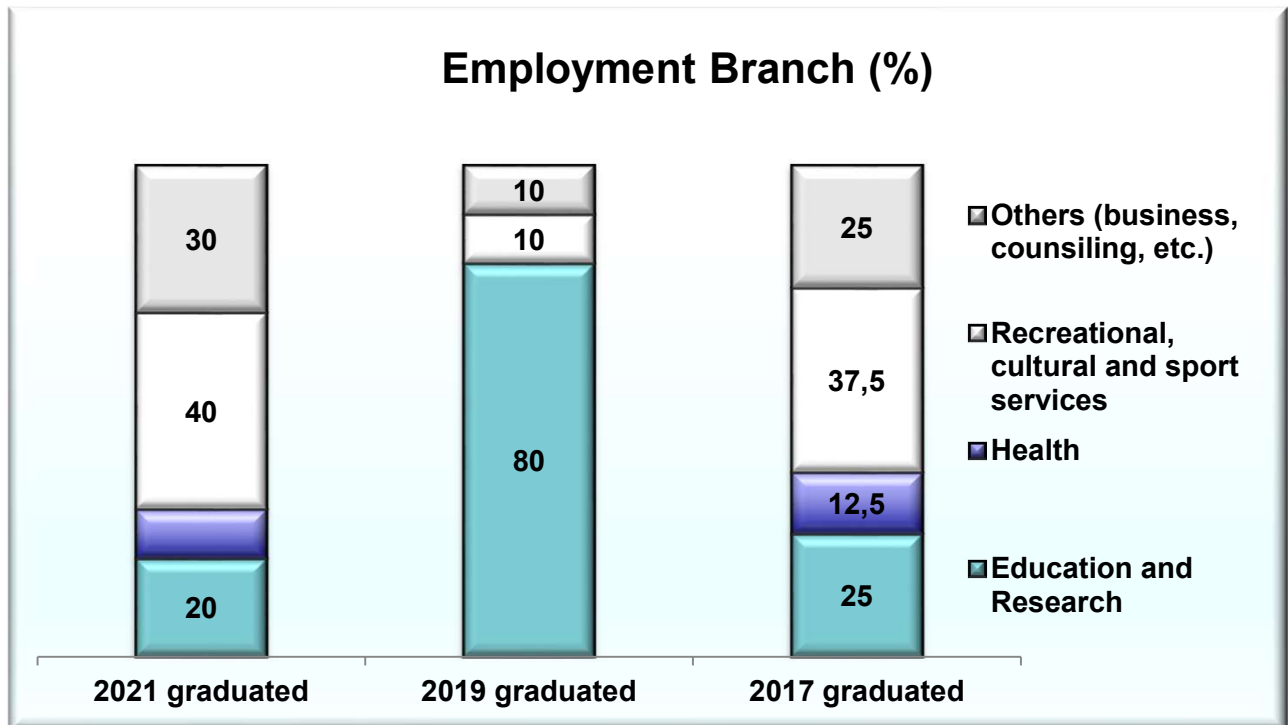
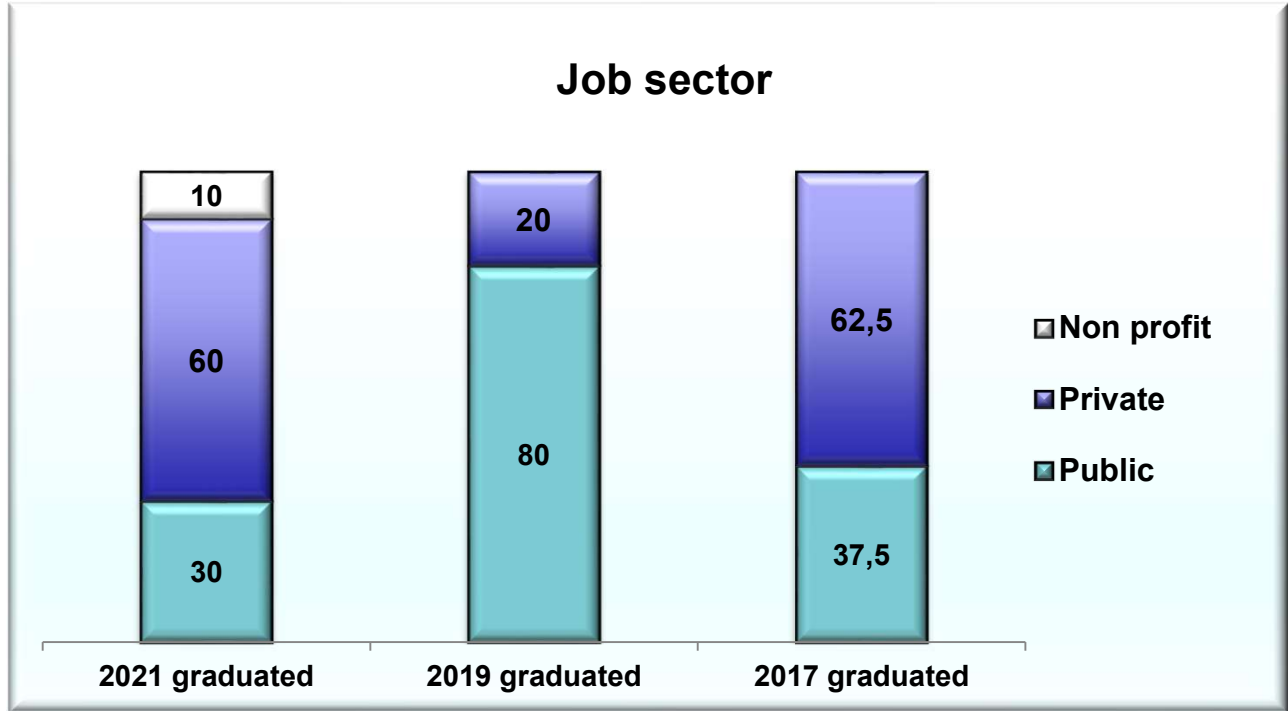

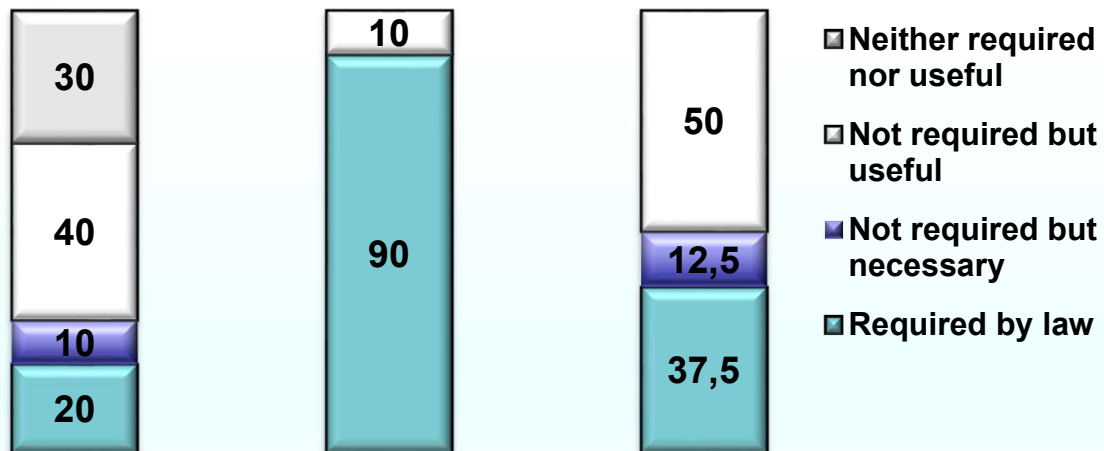

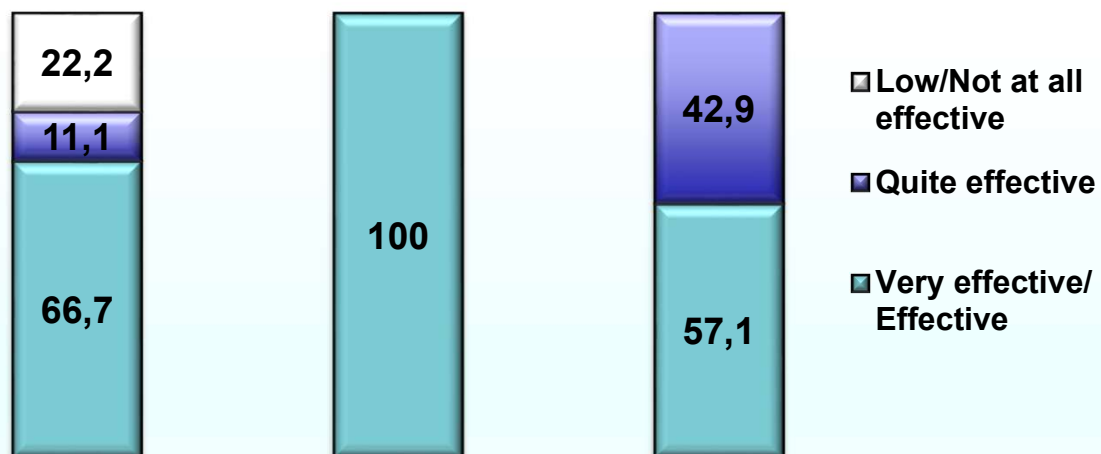

## Effectiveness of the degree in the current job (%)

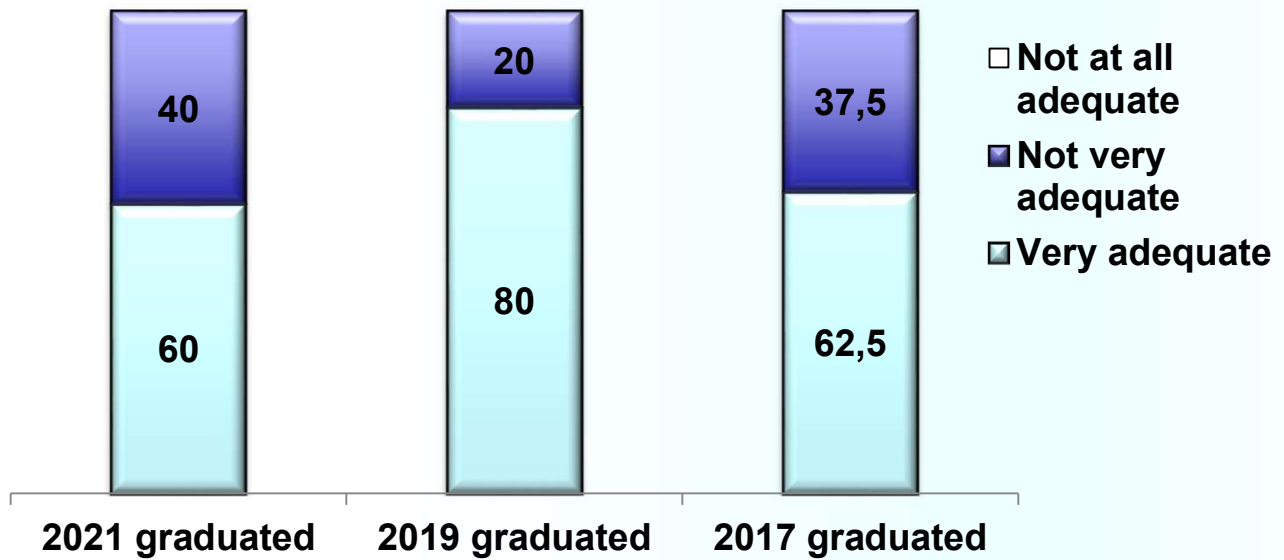
